

## Caption images

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I got bored with my calendar (even though I've now added multiple colours according to events) and wanted an image over the calendar just like you have on printed ones.

I'm finishing off a patch that does this.

It has 4 options,

0 = default i.e. not image in the caption

1 = use an image name that is made up from the month number i.e. 1-12.type

2 = used a fixed image name of 0.type

3 = use a random image name from 1-12.type

The event calendar options will allow you to select the option (0-4 above), the path e.g. images/eventcal/, the image type e.g. .jpeg or .png

Here is an example using mytest server with option of a fixed image i.e. 0.jpeg,

It's actually really simple code change but give me a day or two to finish testing.

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Have changed that to 5 options,

0 = default i.e. no image in the caption

1 = fixed image name of 0.type

2 = image name that is made up from the month number i.e. m1-m12

3 = pick a random image from the months using mt\_rand(1,12)

4 = image name that is made up from the weekday number i.e. d0-d6

5 = pick a random image from the days using mt\_rand(0,6)
