Hi there,
I'm using your module on my site, and it works like a charm. The only thing I would like to add, is the category name after a description in the tooltip box. I.e.: when standing on a date with events, a tooltip box will appear. This box shows the number of events, and right underneath the title of those events, planned on that day. I would like to add the category right after these titles... So instead of...
1 Event
FooBar Title
I Would like...
1 Event
FooBar Title (FooBar Category)
It seems as something that would be easy to fit in... Seems.

The calendar doesn't retrieve the category information at the moment from the database, so the database query would have to change to get the category and then code would need to be added to then pass it back to be displayed. if you are into coding - give it a go. I don't have a lot of time at the moment.

OK to

get the Category Name from the SQL, in helper.php, change:

SELECT a.dates, a.times, a.enddates,a.title, DAYOFMONTH(a.dates) AS created_day, YEAR(a.dates) AS created_year, MONTH(a.dates) AS created_month'

to:

SELECT a.dates, a.times, a.enddates,a.title, c.catname, DAYOFMONTH(a.dates) AS created_day, YEAR(a.dates) AS created_year, MONTH(a.dates) AS created_month'

Then a bit further down in the code, modify:

 \$title = htmlspecialchars(\$event->title);

To become:

 \$title = htmlspecialchars(\$event->title) . '◆(' . \$event->catname . ')';

And

 \$title = \$tt . ' +' . htmlspecialchars(\$event->title);

To be:

 \$title = \$tt . ' +' . htmlspecialchars(\$event->title) . '◆(' . \$event->catname . ')';

(I admit I know little about what I'm changing there and it's possible only one of those lines is actually necessary. I suspect for full hack-resistance you should probably wrap the "\$event->catname" inside a htmlspecialchars call too but I don't know for sure and the above worked for me so...)

Please use htmlspecialchars. This deals with things like quotes and ampersands if you have them in your Category names.

htmlspecialchars(\$event->catname)

Thanks for looking into it. I never had time.
I'll add this as an option in the next version of the calendar I bring out.
