Hi

Please can you check which version of Joomla you have and which calendar. I have had to release a new version of the calendar to go with Joomla 1.5.23 as a change to Joomla caused a problem.

Make sure you get the calendar for Joomla 1.5.23 if you have that version. And if you have a lower version of Joomla - the advice is upgrade to the latest - and get the calendar to go with it.

If that isn't the problem please check if you have enabled the new Mootools. The tooltips on the 1.5.x calendar works with the older Mootools. The Joomla 1.6 calendar has been upgraded to work with the newer Mootools

I found error in mod_ajaxloader.php on line 65:

```
SELECT id, title, module, position, content, showtitle, control, params'  
. ' FROM #__modules AS m'...
```

You have to remove control from SELECT statement because field control not exists in table modules anymore.
